If residence permit is missing, it can be presented within 6 month after the import.</p> <p>Please note that these goods are admitted as duty free only temporarily.</p>
Used household goods and personal effects - Czech citizens returning	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Photocopy of passport. • Power of attorney to authorise the removal agent to represent the importer with the customs authorities. • Inventory list. • Copy of Czech ID card. • Declaration according to "Remarks" (confirmation from a company or Embassy, or proved by stamps in passport or Visa of foreign country). 	Duty free	<p>All documents must be in the Czech language. The client can import his goods to Czech Republic provided:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • He was living abroad for a period longer than 12 months. • His goods have been used abroad for more than 6 months before he left for Czech Republic.
Diplomat's removal	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Power of attorney to authorise the removal agent to represent the importer with the customs authorities. • Inventory list. • "JCD" (Embassy Import Declaration) for commercial goods or Vehicles. 	Duty free	
Automobiles and motorcycles	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Original/copy of invoice or purchasing contract. • Car title and technical book of the car 		<p>Duty free, subject of re-exportation. During temporary importation period the car must not be sold.</p>

Alcohol and cigarettes	As for removal household goods and personal effects.	Duty free (as a part of shipment with used household goods).	The importation duty-free limit is: 2 litres of wine 1 litre of hard drink 200 cigarettes or 250 grams of tobacco.
Animals	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Veterinary import permission issued by state vet office in Prague, Czech Republic. • Veterinary certificate issued by the state vet office in the country of the animal origin. • International vaccination certificate. 	Duty free	
Firearms	Document issued by the Embassy of Czech Republic from the country the customer lives in.	Duty free (as a part of shipment with used household goods).	After the customs clearance in Czech Republic, the firearms have to be given over to a police department until the client will get the Czech firearms licence.
