Used household goods and personal effects - Foreign citizens	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Photocopy of residency permit.</li> <li>• Phonology of housing contract (the rental period has to be for minimum of 24 months).</li> <li>• Photocopy of passport.</li> <li>• <b>The importer's employer is required to write on a letterhead paper, that the Foreign Citizen will be working within his company (work certificate/Prohlaseni).</b></li> <li>• Power of attorney to authorise the removal agent to represent the importer with the customs authorities.</li> <li>• <b>Inventory list</b></li> </ul>	Duty free, subject of re-exportation.	<p>All documents must be in the Czech language.</p> <p>Customs clearance is not possible if the housing contract is missing. <b>If residence permit is missing, it can be presented within 6 month after the import.</b></p> <p>Please note that these goods are admitted as duty free only temporarily.</p>
Used household goods and personal effects - Czech citizens returning	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Photocopy of passport.</li> <li>• Power of attorney to authorise the removal agent to represent the importer with the customs authorities.</li> <li>• Inventory list.</li> <li>• Copy of Czech ID card.</li> <li>• Declaration according to "Remarks" (confirmation from a company or Embassy, or proved by stamps in passport or Visa of foreign country).</li> </ul>	Duty free	<p>All documents must be in the Czech language. The client can import his goods to Czech Republic provided:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• He was living abroad for a period longer than 12 months.</li> <li>• His goods have been used abroad for more than 6 months before he left for Czech Republic.</li> </ul>
Diplomat's removal	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Power of attorney to authorise the removal agent to represent the importer with the customs authorities.</li> <li>• Inventory list.</li> <li>• <b>"JCD" (Embassy Import Declaration) for commercial goods or Vehicles.</b></li> </ul>	Duty free	
Automobiles and motorcycles	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b>Original/copy</b> of invoice or purchasing contract.</li> </ul>		<p>Duty free, subject of re-exportation. During temporary importation period the car must not be sold.</p>

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Car title and technical book of the car</li> <li>Power of attorney to authorise the removal agent to represent the importer with the customs authorities.</li> <li>Photocopy of residency permit.</li> <li>Photocopy of housing contract (the rental period has to be for minimum of 24 months).</li> <li>Photocopy of passport.</li> </ul>		The car should not be older than <b>5 years</b> and younger than 6 months.
Alcohol and cigarettes	As for removal household goods and personal effects.	Duty free (as a part of shipment with used household goods).	The importation duty-free limit is: 2 litres of wine 1 litre of hard drink 200 cigarettes or 250 grams of tobacco.
Animals	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Veterinary import permission issued by state vet office in Prague, Czech Republic.</li> <li>Veterinary certificate issued by the state vet office in the country of the animal origin.</li> <li>International vaccination certificate.</li> </ul>	Duty free	
Firearms	Document issued by the Embassy of Czech Republic from the country the customer lives in.	Duty free (as a part of shipment with used household goods).	After the customs clearance in Czech Republic, the firearms have to be given over to a police department until the client will get the Czech firearms licence.
Other goods			There may be specific customs regulations, so you should consult your agent in advance.
