| Removal Goods<br><i>citizens (non Greeks) moving to Greece from a Non EU country</i> | <u>From agent:</u><br>- Packing list clearly stating all electrical appliances with brands, models and serial numbers<br>- OBL/AWB<br><u>From customer:</u><br>- Authorization form<br>- Declaration from<br>- Photocopy of passport<br><b>Note: Authorization and declaration forms need to be legalized by local police station (in Greece)</b> | <b>Taxes/duties are payable</b>                   | <b>Unless customer is working for a company who services a particular duty free status (i.e. contract with Greek Government).</b>  |
| Removal Goods –<br><i>Greeks moving to Greece from a Non EU country</i>              | <u>From agent:</u><br>- Packing list<br>- OBL/AWB<br><u>From customer:</u><br>- Original Certificate of repatriation<br>- Original passports (old & new) of   | Duty free entry with certificate of repatriation. | Consignee must have lived abroad for over two year (continuously).<br><br>It is advisable to contact your Greek agent as regulations & requirements can change without prior notice. |

| <p>Removal Goods<br/><i>Cars &amp; motorbikes</i></p>                            | <p><u>From agent:</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Packing list</li> <li>- OBL/AWB</li> </ul> <p><u>From customer:</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Original certificate of title for vehicle</li> <li>- Original registration card</li> <li>- Copy of driving license</li> <li>- Greek or International Insurance</li> <li>- Copy of Diplomatic passport / ID</li> <li>- Letter from Embassy certifying diplomat's commencement of employment.</li> <li>- Consignee's presence at customs is required for collection of vehicle.</li> </ul> | <p>Options:</p> <p>a. <u>Tourist Law:</u> Temporary customs clearance. Customer can drive vehicle in Greece with foreign plates for six months. After that period vehicle has to be re-exported.</p> <p>b. <u>Payment of taxes/duties</u> is applicable and depends on vehicles cc.</p> <p>c. <u>Certificate of repatriation:</u> Payment only of Greek License plates.</p> | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Regarding motorbikes their chassis has to have at least seventeen (17) digits.</li> <li>- Either car or motorbike has to be under the latest European manufacturing standards (i.e. cannot be old)</li> </ul> |
